Now imagine yourself as a person in the crowd who is getting fed by 12 men walking around with one basket a piece. What would be going through your mind as you are watching and waiting for your turn to be fed?

Finally, imagine being in the crowd as the disciples walk through again to pick up leftovers. What would you be thinking and feeling as you saw each basket full again with leftovers?
