Scripture

Read Matthew 21:1-11

In the message Ben gave us four reasons why generosity is not only aTypical but it is ridiculous and incredible

- It's incredible that God would ask us for anything
- It's incredible that Jesus rides into town on the generosity of ordinary people
- It's incredible that our generosity writes us into the story of God
- It's incredible he got the donkeys back

With these points in mind, why do you feel it's incredible that God would ask us for anything? Why did Jesus ride in to town on a donkey when he could have made a bigger entrance?

Ben said "God uses the generosity of ordinary people in extraordinary ways." How do you feel God has used your generosity in extraordinary ways? Give an example of how your generosity has written you into the story of God.
