- 3. God demonstrated His love in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
- 4. When we connect in a group, we have the opportunity to practice loving others as God loves us.

SCRIPTURES USED IN THIS MESSAGE: John 15:12, 1 John 4:8, John 15:13, Romans 5:8 RESPOND

What are some things that you have chased and chased after, looking for more of something, but not found that sense of satisfaction?

The more that does satisfy is the more that is found in a relationship with the person of Jesus Christ. List what you have received "More" of in your relationship with Jesus.

Read John 15:12 If you want more love, how do you usually go about getting it?

How is Jesus saying we should go about getting more love? Talk about some practical ways that we can help others experience more love.

Read John 15:13-14 What is the greatest expression of love that one could show to another? Talk about someone you know that would, "lay down their life" for you or another friend.

Consider taking time this week to express love toward another person. Share the name of a person you will intentionally love this week.

Talk to someone you know who is not in a group right now. Encourage them to give groups a try so they can love others and be loved by others!
